Program Guidelines

The Self-Help Home Repair Program provides grants, tools and training to income eligible homeowners for home repairs in Genesee and Orleans Counties. The following program requirements are used to determine eligibility:

- Household income within the program guidelines (see income limits).
- The homeowner must provide the majority of the labor to make the repairs.
- Owner occupied single family home.
- Property value within the maximum FHA mortgage limits.
- Property taxes paid up to date.
- Proof of current homeowner's insurance
- Current on mortgage payments
- House is located in the target counties
- Funds can only be used for the approved improvements

- Plumbing system repairs
- Heating system repairs or replacement
- Electrical system upgrades
